

In addition to filling out all the proper paperwork required and displayed on the Parkway Christian Academy website (including Financial Responsibility), the International Students are also responsible for the following:

- If the student is unavailable to meet in person, the student will have a Skype interview with PCA administration prior to admission acceptance.
- When the student arrives at PCA, the student will be given an ESL placement test. The international student must accept and perform the ESL recommendations in order to continue to attend PCA.
- Upon arrival – the ITEP will be administered by PCA. The cost of this will be passed to the parent of the International Student.

ITEP Results should fall into these ranges:

9th Grade = 3.5

10th Grade = 4.0

11th-12th Grade= 4.5

- PCA International students are expected to participate in the Christian activities of the campus community, including one chapel per week.
- After class attendance of three weeks, international students' mastery of the English language will be reevaluated and if determined by the administration, the student will have to attend English tutoring classes. This will involve additional expenses to the student.
- Tutoring is a requirement for all international students: Two days a week for an hour and a half at a time (minimal). This is to start the first week the student arrives at PCA. This fee will be included in the student's upfront payment.
- PCA students, including International Students, who exhibit certain behaviors can and will result in immediate dismissal with no return or refund.
- Students need to be academically motivated and have a proven record of being successful in school. This will be demonstrated by:
Assignments turned in on time
Speaking English only (when requested to do so)
Attend and participate in all help sessions
NO SLEEPING IN CLASS

In signing this contract the student and parents realize at any time the International Student can be expelled and sent home with no refund.
