Discounts – A 10% discount is offered on your second and subsequent children's tuition. This applies only to your immediate family.

Curriculum/Activity Fees- Additional activity fees are **NOT** required. All activities, field trips, and morning snack costs are covered in your tuition. Tuesday and Thursday lunch is also covered in your tuition.

Payments- Each week's payment is due on Monday of that week to not incur a \$25 late payment fee. Payments may be given to the staff on duty. We accept money orders and personal checks only, no cash payments. If an account becomes 1 week past due, the student(s) are subject to be dismissed from the program until the account is paid in full. In the event of your child's dismissal, you will be required to pay a \$20.00 re-enrollment fee before your child can return.

Discipline

Please read the guidelines below, sign, and return with your registration form.

Guidelines

1. Campers must respect themselves, other campers, counselors, and all property at and away from PCA.
2. Bad language will not be tolerated.
3. Behavior that is deemed unsafe or disrespectful by the camp staff will not be allowed.

Procedures for handling behavior problems may include but not be limited to:

1. The camper's parent will be notified of the behavior problem and may be asked to immediately pick up the child.
2. Revoking of one or more privileges – field trips, activities, etc.
3. Time-outs.
4. Sentence writing.
5. Suspension and/or expulsion from camp.

Any repeated behavior issues may lead to the administration requesting a camper's withdrawal from camp. If a camper is dismissed, money paid will not be refunded if the child attended any part of the paid day.

Parents please review this with your children so that they are aware of the behavior expectations for camp.

INFORMATION

- Tennis shoes are required every day.
- Swim days and Water play days – please send a ONE-PIECE bathing suit for the girls, towel, and sun block in a bag. Water shoes may also be worn at Camp Eagle on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
- Camp Eagle days (T, Th): bus leaves at 8:30AM and returns at 4:30PM. IF you are tardy, your child will not be allowed to attend camp that day.
- Respectable clothing must be worn daily—no halter tops, shirts must be worn for boys during the camp day unless swimming.
- Afternoon snacks and Monday, Wednesday, Friday lunch should be brought by the student.
- Morning snacks and lunch on Tuesdays and Thursdays are provided.
- Earliest drop off: 7AM
- Latest pick up: 6PM. You are charged \$1.00 for every minute late according to the time you sign your child out for the day.
